Two Nova Scotia Sailors and one coach have been selected by the Canadian Yachting Association to represent Canada at the Volvo Youth World Sailing Championships in Zadar, Croatia.

Julien Fougere and Henry Machum, from the Royal Nova Scotia Yacht Squadron will compete in the 420 Class while RNSYS Coach Agustin Ferrario will be the team leader.

The competition will be held at the Sailing Club Uskok venue from July 7 -16th.

Warren Nethercote will be offering a Club Judge Seminar in conjunction with the SMSC Bay-Wind regatta, on the weekend of 23-24 July. The seminar will consist of classroom sessions covering Parts 5, 6 and 7 of the Racing Rules of sailing, followed by a 50 question true-false test.
